THIRD IGUESS GIS TRAINING WORKSHOP

EUROGEO, the European non-governmental scientific and educational society, will host a one-week Comenius training seminar for Geography teachers and lecturers in Dublin from 29 May to 5 June 2012.

This event (reference BE-2012-196-001) follows-up successful courses in Geel, Belgium, and Athens, Greece, both based on the very successful iGuess Project – Integrating GIS in secondary education in several subjects (www.iguess.eu). The course is devoted to spatial thinking and the use of GIS in learning and teaching. Participants will learn about the practical and pedagogical uses of ArcGIS in schools and in teaching geography.

The EC has accredited the course which will allow teachers and teacher educators to apply for Comenius grants to cover the course fees and travel/subsistence costs. Course details can be found at:



The first event, in Belgium, was attended by more than 25 participants from 16 countries across Europe. 27 teachers and teacher educators attended the second course in Athens last June.
